ΠΑΟΚ - ΒΡΙΛΙΣΣΙΑ 22-26

Day 2 of the 2nd International Handball Tournament Vrilittos commenced with a spectacular match between Vrilissia and PAOK. The Athenian team of Vrilissia edged the club from Thessaloniki 25-22, despite a one-goal advantage (14-13) PAOK gained at the break. After five minutes of play in the second half, Vrilissia took the lead and they never lost it despite a late surge from PAOK.

Sotiris Tontorovits (Vrilissia Coach): "After losing our first choice goalkeeper due to injury, all my players gave an oath to play for him, but also to try their best to make the life of our other goalkeeper easier. And so they did, as our keeper was one of the best players on court. We played very well and I am pretty satisfied."

Alexis Papavasilis (PAOK Coach): "It was a fascinating game between two teams of the same caliber. Our opponents kept their temper in shooting in the decisive moments of the game and that's why we lost."
